WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

- Linens, towels, pillows, blankets
- Water bottle that you can refill and carry with you
- Closed toe, closed heel shoes (for outdoor activities) -- for more information see the dress code section below
- Bible, notepad, and pen
- Toiletries such as toothbrush and shampoo
- Sun protection
- Spending money for snacks, Fuge store, and missions offering (optional)
- **DO NOT BRING** alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, fireworks, water guns, or any kind of weapon
- **DO NOT BRING** radios, iPods, CD players, roller blades, skateboards -- cell phones are at the discretion of the Group Leader – but are not to be carried around during the day at camp

PARTY INFORMATION

Centri-Kid and Crosspoint "parties" are camp wide activities that happen at night and are just for fun! Sometimes the party is in a game show format and sometimes it is a recreation based activity. The setting may be indoors or outside. The party on the last evening of camp is a chance to see what the performance track times have been working on all week.

DAMAGES

Please be aware that your group is personally responsible for any damages to any facilities including but not limited to the dorm rooms your group occupies.

You will also be asked by the facility to pay for any lost keys.

DRESS CODE

Please ask your students not to pack anything that:

- Advertises alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs
- Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person
- Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations
- Has spaghetti straps, except for sleepwear
- Is excessively short or tight fitting.

While at camp, we ask that students and adults:

- Wear modest one-piece bathing suits or two piece suits covered with a colored T-shirt.
- Wear modest shorts for worship. Dresses, slacks, or jeans are OK for worship too. NOTE: long pants or knee-length skirts are required for on-stage performances.
- Do not dress in a way that calls attention to the underwear (sagging pants, rolling down waistbands, etc)
- Wear a dark t-shirt if planning to take a messy games or water games track.

We invite you to join us as leaders in monitoring your group to ensure they are dressing appropriately.
