

# Tic tac Toe

## BAPTISM TIC TAC TOE RULES

Prior to class arrange 3 rows of 3 chairs like a tic-tac-toe board. Instruct youth to play tic-tac-toe in order to test their knowledge of key points about baptism. Group the youth in 2 teams and designate one team as the X team and the other as the O team. Flip a coin to determine which team will go first. Read the question to one student from that team. If he or she correctly answers the question, he or she takes a seat on the tic-tac-toe board. The teammates may help him or her to choose the chair. If the team member answers incorrectly, the other team gets to choose a space on the board. (If you have a small class, group students into teams and provide masking tape to create Xs and Os on the chairs.) Continue taking turns until all youth have had a turn or all questions have been answered. The first team to mark three in a row wins.

## BAPTISM QUIZ QUESTIONS FOR TIC TAC TOE

True or False.

1. Baptism is a picture of salvation but it does not save you. (True, Holman Student Bible Dictionary, p. 38)
2. Baptism is a symbol of death. (False. It is a symbol of death, burial, and resurrection; Rom. 6:4)
3. Water baptism is for those who believe in God rather than for babies. (True; Acts 2:38; Holman Student Bible Dictionary, p. 40.)
4. Jesus' baptism was a baptism of repentance. (False. Jesus was sinless, so He did not need to repent. Matt. 3:15; 2 Cor. 5:21; Holman Student Bible Dictionary, p. 40.)
5. Jesus was not the first person to be baptized. (True)
6. John the Baptist began baptizing believers after Jesus' ministry began. (False. John the Baptist began baptizing before the ministry of Jesus. John 1:19-34)
7. John the Baptist baptized Jesus in the Sea of Galilee. (False. Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River. John 1:28-34)
8. The term "Baptist" refers to Christian churches that baptize believers by immersion, by fully putting their bodies underneath water. (true; Holman Student Bible Dictionary, p. 41)
9. A baptistry is a watertight tank large enough for one person to completely immerse another person. (True)
10. Baptism is an option for all followers of Jesus Christ. (False. Baptism is a command. Matt. 28:18-20)
