You can pray in your room.

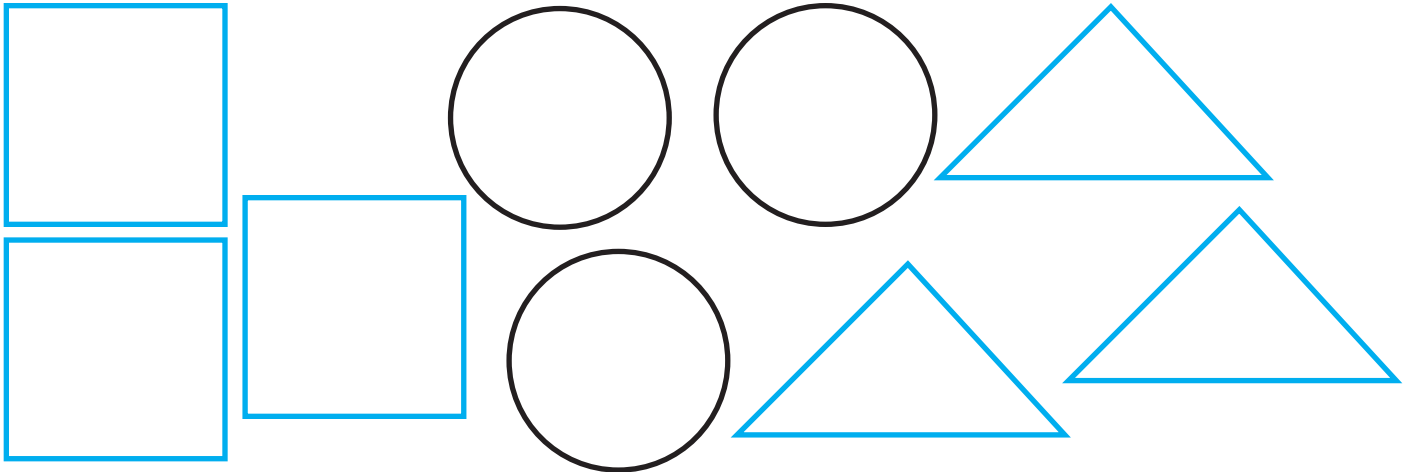
Mark 1:35

## Prayer Places

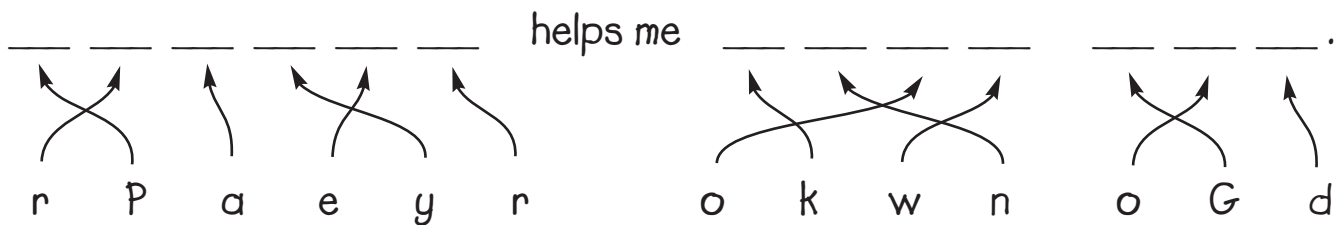
Prayer is talking to God. You can talk to God any time. You can tell God anything.
