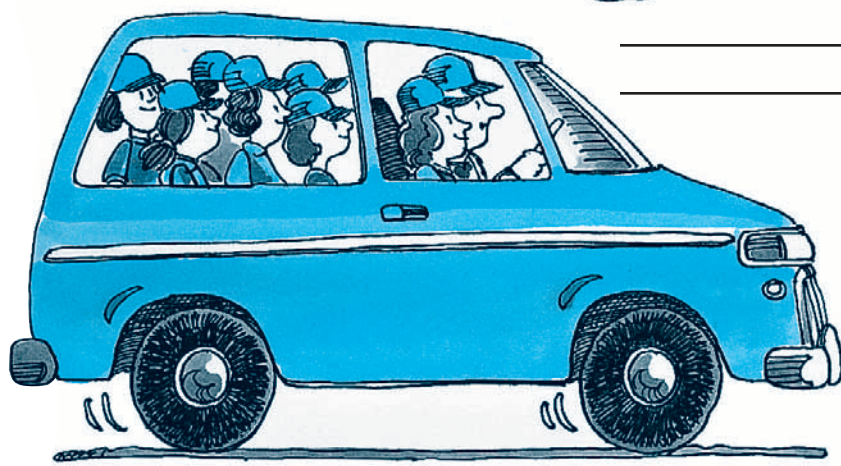
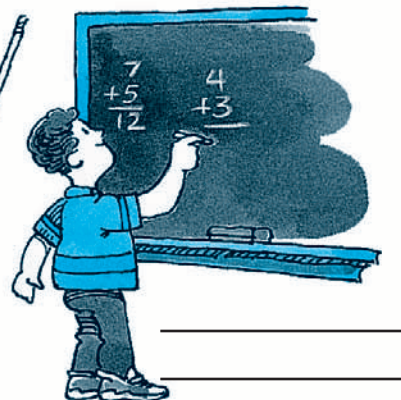

## When and Where?

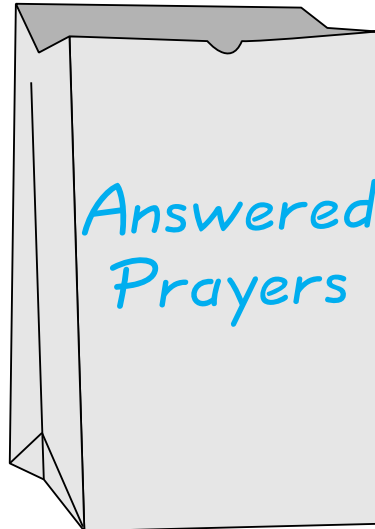
Look at the pictures. On the lines print a time and place you might pray aloud or silently.



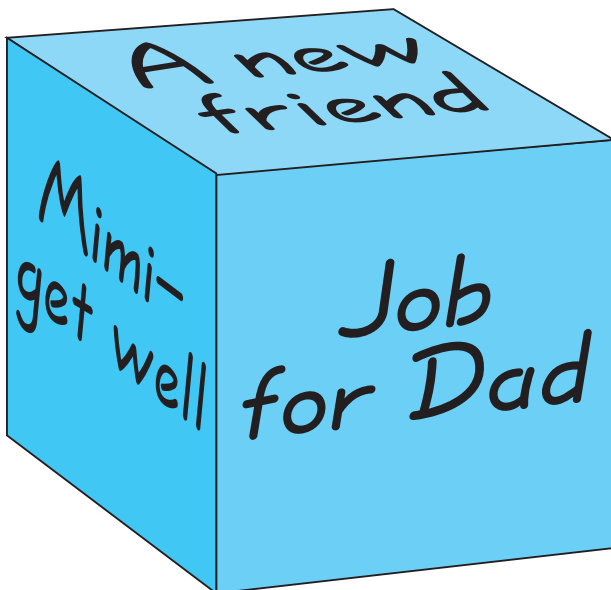
## Prayer Activities for the Family

Choose one of these prayer activities to do with your family.

1. On two lunch sacks print the titles shown here. Provide slips of paper on which family members may write prayer requests. To use for family prayers, draw prayer requests from the first sack. When a prayer has been answered, put the slip in the “answered prayer” sack.



2. Obtain or make a square box. On each side print something you and your family are praying for. For family prayer time, pass the box around. Each person may choose a different side, pray, then pass the box to the next person. Continue until all six sides have been used for prayer. Use the box in a similar way for your private prayer time.
