

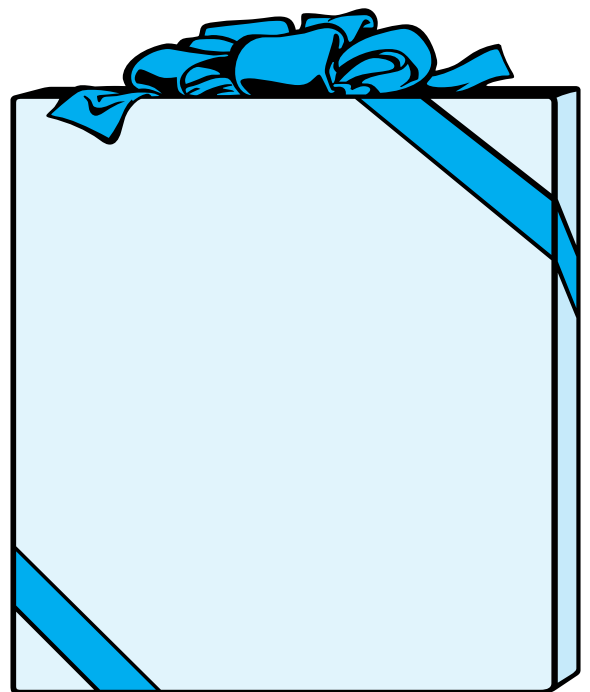
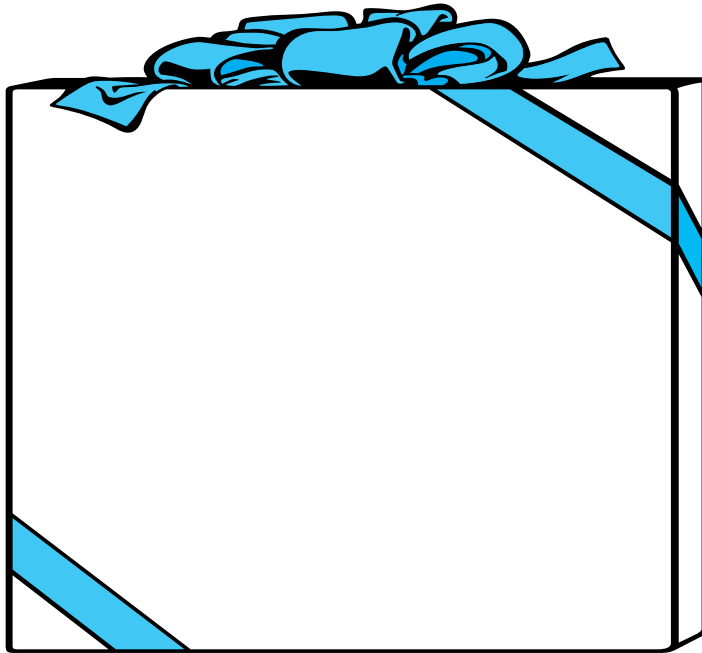

Unwrapping Your Gifts

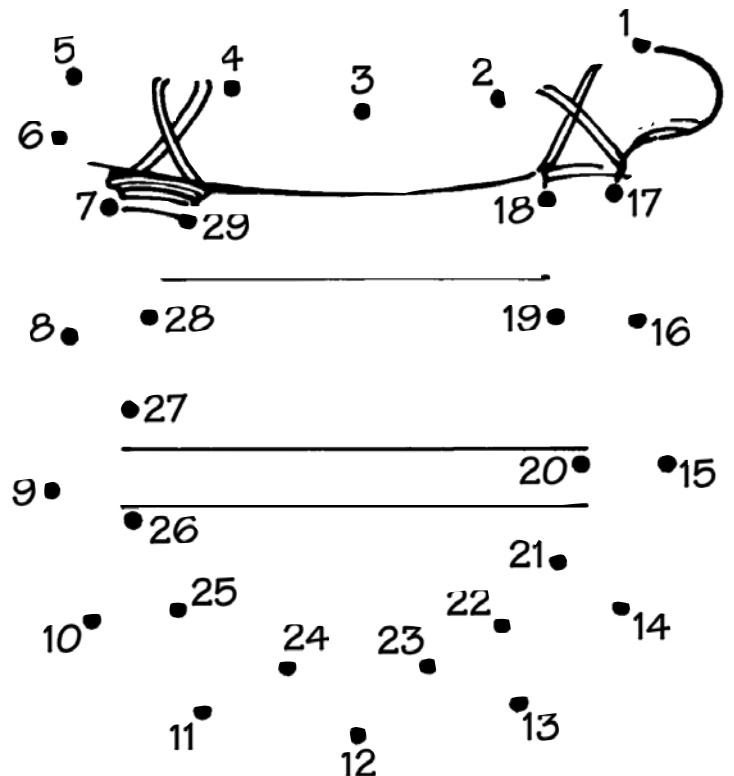
God gives each of us things we can do well. Think about the things you do well. Draw a picture in each box of one thing you do well.
