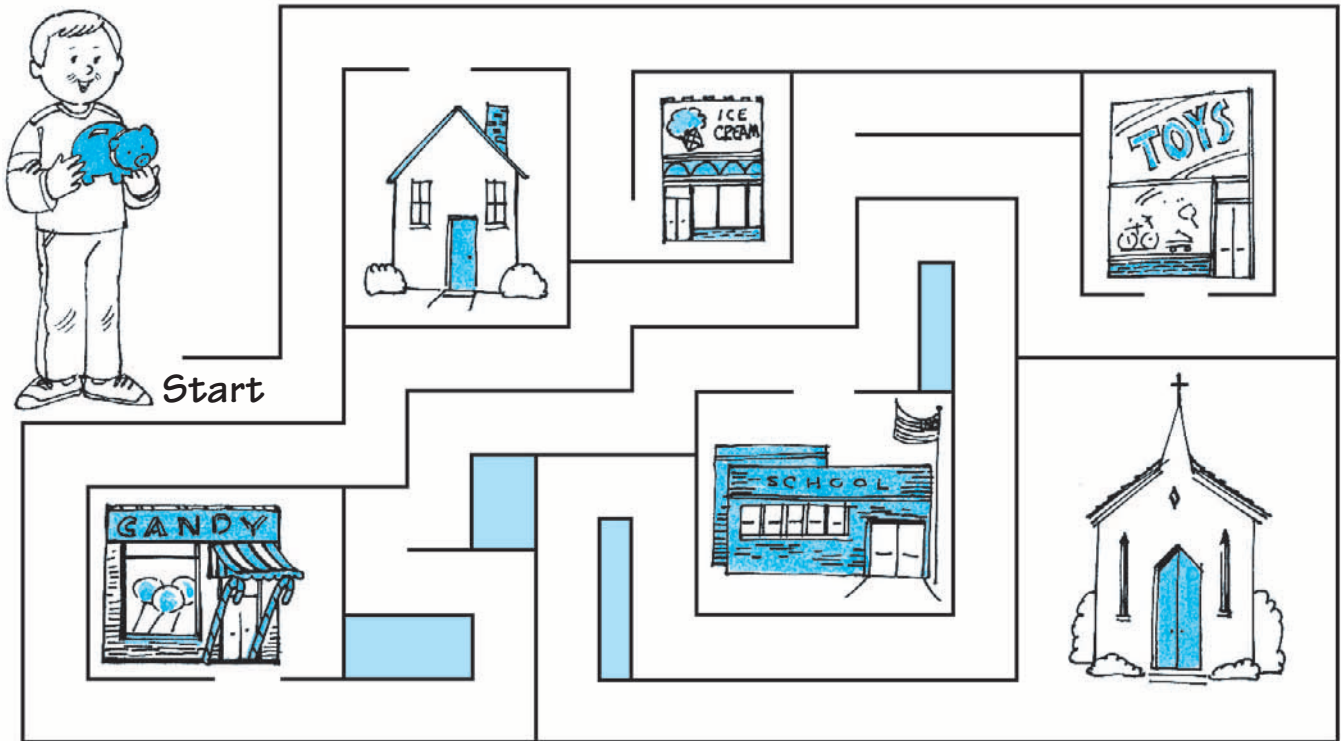


# My Money Can Help

Money that Ministered (Philippians 4:10-20)

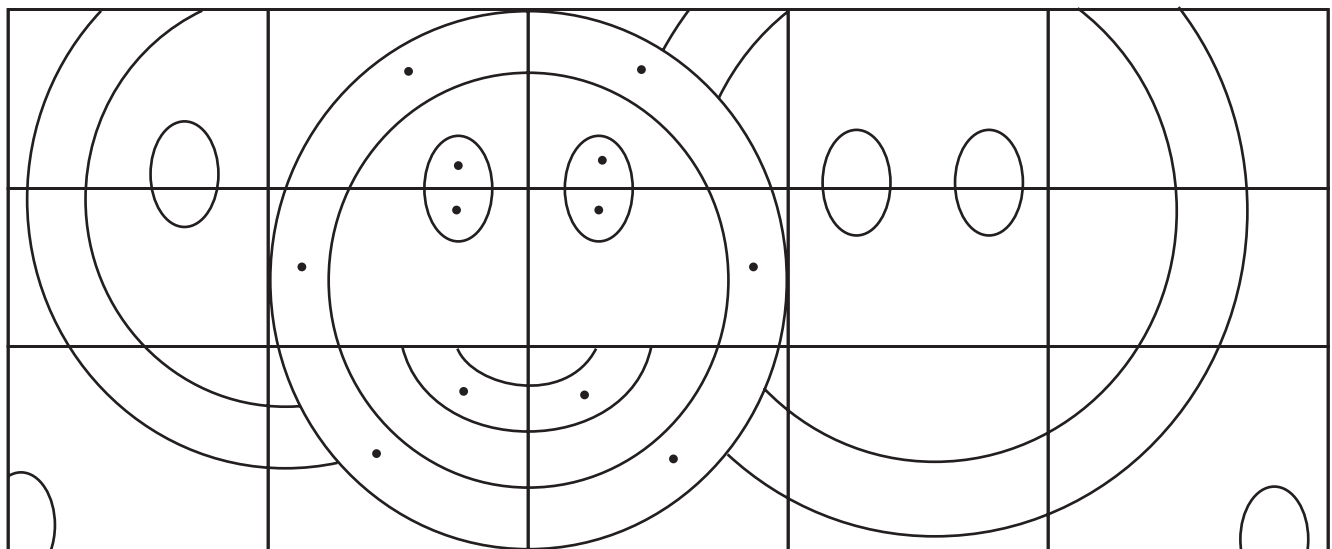
## Money Maze

## How Does My Family Use Money

Play this game with another member of your family. If more than two people want to play, play in teams. This game is similar to ticktacktoe. Use the following directions.

After you have played the game several times, locate and read Luke 12:15, Proverbs 22:1, 1 Peter 4:10, and 2 Corinthians 9:7. Talk about these verses with your family.

### Directions

- Cut out five circles from blue construction paper and five circles from red construction paper.
- Print one of the following phrases on each circle: *use for needs*, *use for fun*, and *use for help*.
- Decide which color each person or team will be.
- Before a player can put a place marker on the gameboard, he or she must name a way your family uses money for family needs, for family fun, or to help someone else, depending on what his or her place marker says.
- The first player to score three-in-a-row wins.
